Techniques learned: Setting up pillow, setting in pins, winding bobbins, cloth stitch and half stitch.
Project: You will leave with a small Butterfly bobbin lace project in hand.

Techniques learned: May include chaining, single crochet, double crochet, proper handling of thread, tensioning techniques and other hints. A lot depends on time, and how fast you learn.

Beginning Tatting – Peacock Heart **Teacher:** Kathleen Cantwell
Fee: \$10.00 **Time:** 1:00 – 3:00 **Supplies:** Provided. **Class size:** 5
Techniques learned: May include double stitch, picot, ring, chain, reverse work, continuous thread, and using ball and shuttle together. A lot depends on time, and how fast you learn.
Project: You will leave with a small Tatted Heart project in hand.



Princess Charming Scissor Fob (Kumihimo)* **Teacher:** Tracy Jackson
Fee: \$25.00 **Time:** 1:00 – 3:00 **Class size:** 12
Supplies: Kumihimo disc, two colors of **embroidery floss** (1 skein each), Scissors (can be purchased), beads, charms optional.
Project: This is a basic technique for kumihimo using a 32-slot disc with an extra twist. The loop is braided directly around your scissors, transitioning from an 8 to 16-strand braid. Charms and beads may be added to the tassel. The fee includes cost of the disc. No experience necessary.
