I have been using the computer to draft patterns for old lace. This lace was made by the late Catherine Stirrup of Florida. I analyzed the lace and drafted the pricking below.

The first diamond is filled with half stitch ground. The second diamond has a compound spider. The diamonds are surrounded by rosepoint.

Ms. Stirrup worked two different sewing edges on this sample. The left edge is a whole stitch with two passives. The right edge is cloth stitch with three passives.
